



CAUTION











Shade

Mounting Screws




Wire Nuts

STEP 1

Use the $\mbox{\bf mounting screws}$ to attach the $\mbox{\bf mounting unit}$ to the junction box




STEP 2

Make the electrical connection from the junction box to the **fixture**. Connect the ground wire to the **mounting unit** using the preinstalled green ground screw. Then, connect the positive, negative and ground wires with the supplied **wire nuts**. Secure with electrical tape

Connect the black fixture wire to the black supply wire with a wire nut.

Connect the white fixture wire to the white supply wire with a wire nut.

Connect the copper ground wire to the green ground wire with a wire nut.



STEP 3

Install the bulb and tighten the glass by pressing it upwards E26 60W type not Included bulbs.
